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The details of the BER's Macro Service are as follows:

1. Detailed forecasts of the South African macro-economy and selected international macro-economic variables. These are provided in the form of two dedicated publications:
 - Economic Outlook (2 x per year) which contains the 6-year forecast
 - Economic Prospects (4 x per year) which contains the 2-year quarterly forecast

Interim changes in these forecasts are made available on the BER website.

2. Surveys of current conditions in the manufacturing, retail, wholesale, building and automotive sectors. These are provided in the form of dedicated publications.
 - Manufacturing Survey (4 x per year)
 - Retail Survey (4 x per year) which includes the consumer confidence survey
 - Building and Construction (4 x per year)
3. Research notes on current issues of interest in the South African economy.
4. Personal presentations on the outlook for the economy – two presentations per year depending on the client's requirements.
5. Attendance of the annual conference organized by the BER on macro-economic issues by up to three delegates identified by the client (in Johannesburg area (May) or Cape Town area (November)).
6. Access to the restricted components of the BER website.
7. Phone-in service on economic advice, including limited data requests.

In addition all of these publications and research notes are available in electronic format on the BER website.
